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Foreword

The strengthening of the agricultural information base is perceived as a sine quo non for the formulation of policy measures oriented towards the development of the agricultural sector and the national economy. In recognition of this agricultural imperative, the Government of St. Lucia undertook the 1996 St. Lucia Census of Agriculture with financial and technical assistance from the European Union (EU), the Organization of American States (OAS) and the Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO).

The 1996 Agricultural Census has been taken under the World Census Programme 2000 of F.A.O that comprises all the Census of Agriculture conducted in the period 1996-2005. The St. Lucia Census is the first to be held under this programme.

The Introduction to this report shows a historical background of censuses in St. Lucia as well as particular characteristics of the 1996 Census of Agriculture. A second chapter on main censal results allows a quick look at the main characteristics informed by the census and their comparison with previous censuses. The main body of the report deals with the presentation of the tabulation plan.

Data presented on this report provide information as regards:

- number and size of holdings by forms of tenure,
- by legal status of the holder and by total and cropland size;
- area on holdings,
- land distribution by sex and age of the holder,
- land use.
- main permanent and temporary crops,
- livestock,
- machinery and equipment used in agriculture,
- selected practices and facilities,
- employment, and
- some characteristics of the holder's household.

This exercise could not have been as successful without the tremendous support of the farming community, as well as the general public during all censal activities.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. Historical Background

St. Lucia conducted its last Census of Agriculture in 1986. Previous Agricultural Censuses had been taken in 1946, 1961 and 1973/74. Since the last census several changes have occurred in the country. These changes have impacted heavily on the sector in particular and on the national economy in general.

Agriculture is responsible for around 64 percent of the total domestic exports and banana accounts for over 90 percent of agricultural exports. Nevertheless the country is still depending to a large extent on food imports.

In 1994 Hurricane "Debbie" hit the island causing several damages mainly to banana plantations. Besides this fact, there have been concerns on the security of the island's guaranteed market for banana in the United Kingdom after 1993. As a result, the Government embarked on an agricultural diversification programme to improve the general performance of the country's agricultural sector and reduce its dependence on bananas. It was in this frame that the Government initiated the "Programme for Restoration of the Viability Within the Banana-Based Agricultural Sector". This Programmes includes the generation of a database to guide the process of agricultural diversification. It is also in this context that the Government has conducted the 1996 Census of Agriculture. While the results of this census will provide a comprehensive and up-to-date set of data for the agricultural sector, the next step will consist in establishing a system of "current" agricultural statistics using this census as a bench mark.

1.2. Objectives

The 1996 Census of Agriculture has three **main objectives**:

- 1. To collect data on the main structural agricultural variables.
- 2. To provide a frame for future agricultural surveys based on an "On-going Agricultural Information System."
- 3. To increase the capabilities of the Agriculture Planning and Statistical Unit (PSU) in the Ministry of Agriculture, Lands, Fisheries and Forestry to plan, design, collect, process, analyze and disseminate agricultural information.

It has the following **specific objectives**:

- 1. To provide information at national level, administrative district level and enumeration district level on:
 - i) Number, area, number of parcels and form of tenure of agricultural holdings.
 - ii) Legal status of holders.
 - iii) Agricultural land utilization.
 - iv) Sex, age, main occupation, of individual holders and size of their households.
 - v) Proportion of household income from agriculture.
 - vi) Agricultural labor force.
 - vii) Holdings growing specified crops, area under these crops and spatial distribution of crops.
 - viii) Number and type of livestock.
 - ix) Equipment and selected agricultural practices on holdings.
- 2. To feed with desegregated information the Geographic Information System (GIS) of the Ministry of Planning.
- 3. To train technical personnel on census taking, data processing, sampling surveys and data analysis.
- 4. To set the basis for:
 - i) The establishment of a system of "current" agricultural statistics on planted and harvested area, production, yield and forecasting at the PSU level.
 - ii) The establishment of a system of "current" agricultural statistics on livestock at the PSU.
 - iii) In-depth surveys on agricultural practices, costs of production, environment conservationism, agricultural labor force, marketing of agricultural products, credit, income, consumption and condition of living of farmers and their families, the role of women in the agricultural sector, etc.
- 5. To provide information for studies on agricultural and agricultural-related projects.

1.3. Census Legislation

The 1996 Census of Agriculture was conducted in accordance with the Statistical Act No. 13 of 1973. For this particular census the Cabinet approved a censal decree. The censal decree established the year of census taking, the reference year, the main objectives of the census, the main data to collect, the coverage, the office responsible for census taking, the official appointment of the Census Committee and the specific provisions of the Statistics Act, 1973 applied to this census.

1.4. Scope

The 1996 Census of Agriculture collected data on the structures of the agricultural sector. That means, those characteristics which change slowly in time. The broad scope of this Census can be summarized as taking information on the following variables:

- a) holding location;
- b) legal status of holder;
- c) basic demographic characteristics of holder and household;
- d) inventory of production factors:
 - i) source of manpower used on the holding (family workers, hired agricultural workers);
 - ii) number and area of land parcels;
 - iii) area by land use;
 - iv) number of trees by crops;
 - v) number of livestock by type;
 - vi) type of machinery and equipment;
- f) tenure arrangements on production factors:
 - i) land tenure;
- g) other features:
 - i) whether or not:
 - a. irrigation is practiced;
 - b. rotation of crops is practiced;
 - c. land conservation is practiced;
 - d. fertilizers are used;
 - e. pesticides are used;
 - f. high yielding variety seeds are used;
 - g. animal feed is used;
 - h. farm records are kept;
 - i. The holder belongs to farm organizations.
- ii) whether or not other economic activities are carried out as an ancillary activity;

1.5. Coverage

The 1996 Census of Agriculture covered all the island territory excluding the Government Forest Reserve (17000 acres).

For practical reasons, and according to the criteria followed by other Caribbean countries a low minimum size limit was adopted for holdings to be included in the census. However, all households of the country (in rural or urban areas) were visited and a screening form was filled for every household. Those that fulfill the minimum size limit were enumerated by means of a censal questionnaire.

The minimum size limits adopted for this census were the following:

- one-eighth acre of any temporary crop
- 10 bearing trees of any tree crop or 100 mats of banana or plantain.
- one head of cattle
- 2 pigs or 2 goats or 2 sheep or one head of any two.
- 12 poultry or 12 rabbit or 12 heads of poultry and rabbits together.

The mentioned minimum size limits are similar to those of the 1986 census, with the following differences: sheep are added along with pigs and goats; a combination of poultry and rabbits amounting at least 12 heads is added to adopt a similar criterium than in the case of other livestock.

The adopted minimum size limits allow comparisons between the present and previous censuses as well as between censuses of other countries in the area. They are low enough to exclude only courtyard gardens without any "relevant" livestock. "Landless" holdings are included. Anyway, as the screening form has some information on land or livestock and poultry, the information of very small holdings not taken through the main questionnaire was kept and processed.

1.6. <u>Time References</u>

The census reference year was the calendar year 1995. Specific items had the enumeration day as time reference: Holding identification, area, number of parcels, tenure, holder identification and legal status, household members, number of trees and livestock.

1.7. Enumeration Period

The field work was performed during the period January 15, 1996 - March 15, 1996.

1.8. Type of Enumeration.

The 1996 Census of Agriculture was a complete enumeration exercise. All households in the island (the commercial sector of Castries excluded) were visited. For every household a line of a specially designed screening form was filled. This screening form was designed to identify agricultural holdings to be censed. Once an agricultural holding was detected, a censal questionnaire was filled. For purposes of enumeration the twelve Administrative Districts of the country were subdivided in 341 Enumeration Districts (ED). Every enumerator was charged with the enumeration of one or more EDs.

1.9. Census Frame

Data from the 1991 Census of population along with records from other sources (Ministry of Agriculture, farms associations, etc.) served as censal frames. A list of large farms (more than 25 acres) was done prior to the census taking to take care of their coverage.

1.10. Cartography

The base maps used for the 1991 Population Census (some of them updated at 1992) at the Central Statistical Office were used to redraw the ED maps. Field checkings were done to update and improve the base maps.

1.11. Organization of Census

The 1996 Census of Agriculture was organized on a hierarchical basis. The PSU at the Ministry of Agriculture, Land, Fisheries and Forestry was the office in charge to conduct the census. The exercise was carried out in collaboration with the Central Statistics Office. A multi-institutional Census Committee was appointed to promote and oversee the Agricultural Census. The Chief Agricultural Planning Officer was responsible for the general coordination of the census, with the Planning and Statistics Unit (PSU) serving as Census Office.

As far as the field work is concerned, a total of 176 enumerators canvassed the country for a period of two months collecting information. They were supervised by 30 supervisors. Three field coordinators completed the censal organization.

The processing of data was done at the PSU. One technician has been responsible for coordinating the work of ten editors, ten coders and eleven data entry clerks.

Censal methodology, final design of questionnaires, final design of tables, edition of census report and design of final analysis was assigned to a Methodological Censal Department inside PSU.

1.12. Preparatory Work

Preparatory work for the 1996 Census of Agriculture started as early as January 1995 with the establishment of the National Censal Committee. The definition of the census methodology, a first draft of the censal questionnaire, tabulation plan and instruction manuals were prepared during June and July 1995. A workshop for main users of censal information was developed on July 19, 1995. Programing activities for processing the censal data started in August 1995.

The cartographic exercise was developed between August and December 1995. The pilot census was taken in mid October 1995. Adjustment of censal forms, tables and manuals, were done immediately after the pilot census. Recruitment of field personnel and preparation of censal forms and supplies, were performed by the end of the year. Training courses for supervisors and enumerators were developed during the period January 3 to January 13, 1996.

A publicity plan was approved for the National Census Committee in July 1995 and the publicity campaign undertaken up to the end of the field work. This campaign comprised: press releases through radio and TV, newspaper articles about the census, banners, involvement of religious organizations, schools' billboard competition and personal contact with farmers by extension officers.

1.13 Post Enumeration Activities

During and after the enumeration phase several activities to ensure the quality of data and a correct processing of information were carried out. About 20 holdings per ED were revisited by supervisors in order to check on the quality of data recorded by enumerators. After the ED was completed, and the field checks performed by supervisors, the manual editors edited all questionnaires. When some problem arose and it was not possible to solve it in the office, they sent the questionnaire back to the field in order to correct it.

Once all questionnaires in one ED were ready, they were keypunched. During this process of keypunching, the data entry program also allowed for another level of data verification. Besides that, a validation program to detect inconsistences was run. Only after all data bases were "cleaned" that the final tables were produced. Preliminary tables were checked internally and with external sources to guarantee the accuracy of the final censal data.

2. CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS.

The following are the definitions of the main concepts used for the census of agriculture.

2.1 Holding or farm

An agricultural holding (or farm) is an **economic unit** of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes, without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by an individual or household, jointly by two or more individuals or households or by a juridical person such as a corporation, cooperative or government agency. The holding land may consist of one or more parcels, located in one or more separate areas or in one or more Administrative Districts, providing the parcels share the same production means utilized by the holding, such as labor, farm buildings, machinery or draught animals. (The requirement of sharing the same production means should be fulfilled to a degree to justify the consideration of various parcels as components of one economic unit.)

Economic units engaged <u>solely</u> in forestry and logging or fishing or agricultural services are not considered agricultural holdings because these economic activities are outside agriculture.

It is important to note that the holding does not include lands which are rented out to other persons, but includes lands renting from others.

2.2 Household

A private household consists of one or more persons living together (i.e. sleeping most nights of a week) and sharing at least one daily meal. It is usually formed by a family group but it may consist of two or more families or a group of unrelated persons or a person living alone.

A household usually occupies the whole, part of, or more than one housing unit.

All persons belonging to one household are taken in the census as household members. Members of the holder's household also include the holder himself.

2.3 Holder 1

He is a civil person or a juridical person who exercises management control over the agricultural holding operations and who takes major decisions regarding resource use. The holder has technical and economic responsibility for the holding and may undertake all responsibilities directly, or delegate responsibilities related to day-to-day work management to a hired manager.

Every holding has a holder.

In most of the cases the holder is a person.

When two or more persons, jointly operating a holding, belong to the same household, only one should be regarded as holder and he/she will be the household member who spends more time on holding or, if more than one person spends equal time, the holder will be chosen according to these priorities: father, mother, eldest child and so forth. The others members of the household participating in the work of the farm will be reported as agricultural workers in the farm.

It may happen that different persons belonging to the same household operate different(s) piece(s) of land and the agricultural operation and the production obtained is not shared for all members of the household, in this case, there are more than one holder in the same household and each piece of land becomes a farm.

When two or more persons belonging to different households operate the same holding, each one will be considered as joint holder in the same questionnaire. This is the case of partnerships. In this case, the information about the holder's household will be collected for each household of the joint holders.

When a person, who has two or more households, is operating land for agricultural purposes in the different households with the same production means it will be considered as one farm and one holder.

A holder can operate land which is owned and/or rented from others and/or on a squatter basis and/or under any other form of land tenure. Besides, a holder can operate land without any rights to agricultural use of the land.

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¹To avoid confusion the word *holder* is used instead of *farmer*. A farmer is somebody working in agriculture and the holder may or may not work in the farm.

2.4 Hired Manager

A hired manager is a civic or juridical person who takes technical and administrative responsibility to manage a holding on holder's behalf. Responsibilities are limited to making day-to-day decisions to operate the holding, including managing and supervising hired labor. Payment is generally made in cash and/or in kind. The hired manager is not the holder of the farm he is managing.

2.5 Parcel

A holding parcel is any piece of land entirely surrounded by other land, water, road, forest, etc. not forming part of this holding. A parcel may consist of one or more fields adjacent to each other. A field is a piece of land in a parcel separated from the rest of the parcel by easily recognizable demarcation lines, such as paths, and/or hedges. A field may consist of different plots. A plot is a part or whole of a field on which a specific crop or crop mixture is cultivated.

2.6 Land Use

Land use provides a classification of the holding according to the activity which is directly related to the land, makes use of its resources or has an impact upon it. According to the "Programme for the World Census of Agriculture 2000" of F.A.O. the different land uses have been classified as follows:

1. PRODUCTIVE LAND

1.1. AGRICULTURAL LAND

1.1.1. CULTIVATED LAND

1.1.1.1. CROPLAND

1.1.1.1.1 ARABLE LAND

- Land under temporary crops in open air.
- Land under temporary meadows.
- Land temporarily fallow.
- All other arable land.

1.1.1.2. LAND UNDER PROTECTIVE COVER

- Land under protective cover temporary crops.
- Land under protective cover permanent crops.

1.1.1.3. LAND UNDER PERMANENT CROPS IN OPEN AIR

1.1.2. LAND UNDER PERMANENT MEADOWS AND PASTURES

- Cultivated
- Naturally grown

1.2. WOODLAND OR FOREST

2. ALL OTHER LAND

-Unused and undeveloped potentially productive land

- Land in holding not elsewhere specified.

Chapter 1

MAIN CENSAL RESULTS.

3.1 Number of holdings


The 1996 Census of Agriculture has identified 13366 holdings after screening 38845 households. This figure means an increase of 15.7% in the number of holdings in the ten-year period. Previous (a rate of 1.47 % per year) and an increase of 17.4% in the number of households since the last population census (1991) (an accumulative yearly rate of 3.26%).

Table 1 and Chart 1 depict the total number of agricultural holdings recorded in the last four agricultural censuses

The district of Anse La Raye reflects the highest increase in the number of holdings during the past decade that is 74%. Micoud also recorded a significant increase of 45.4%. The number of holdings in Micoud has more than doubled in the past 22 years. Micoud's proportion in the total number of holdings increased from 9.9% to 18.4%

3.2. Total area on holdings

With respect to total area on holding the 1996 Census of Agriculture reported a total area of 51323.1 acres. This figure reflects a decrease of 6693.4 acres or 11.5% as compared to the last census (1986). Table 3 and Chart 2 show the evolution of the total area in the last four agricultural censuses.




Table 4 shows the evolution of total area on holdings in the last 22 years by Administrative District. It is noted that Castries accounts for the 22.2 % of the total area followed by Micoud with a 21.1%. Generally the Administrative Districts showed a declining trend in total area dedicated to agriculture. Castries was the only exception which showed an increase of area during the last inter-censal period (caused by the increase of area dedicated to agriculture in Castries Rural). The major decreases occurred in Soufriere (-36.6%) and Dennery (-29.2%). The new developments in both administrative districts resulted in a shift from agricultural land to other economic uses.

3.3 Land concentration

The increasing number of holdings and the decline in the agricultural area has had as a consequence, a change in the size structure of holdings. In fact, they are more and more concentrated in small holdings as can be seen in Table No. 5. The increase of almost 2000 holdings since last census is

explained by 780 new landless holdings and 1058 more holdings in the size classes of less than 25 acres of total area. This increase in the number of holdings is compensated by a decrement of 23 holdings in the greater than 25 acres category. This behavior continues a trend observed since 22 years ago.

Looking at the distribution of the area by size, it appears that an increase of area among the holdings under 25 acres (5879.6 acres more than in 1986), while a decrease in total area is noticeable in medium and large holdings (12573.1 acres less than in 1986 for holdings with more than 25 acres of total area). See Table 6 overleaf.

Both changes in the number of holdings and agricultural area caused a smooth trend towards a better distribution of land. In fact, while in 1974, 88% of the smaller holdings with land, held 24% of the land and 0.2% of the larger holdings operated just over 37% of the land, in 1986, 86% of the smaller holdings with land held almost 35% of the land (a better distribution than in 1974) and 0.1% of the larger ones held 30% of the land. For the present agricultural census those figures changed to: 81% of the smaller holdings with land operates almost 48% of the land, while less than 0.1% of the larger holdings hold just under 11% of the total land. The Gini Index for land concentration shows this evolution towards a better distribution of land: 1973/74: 0.90; 1986: 0.87; 1996: 0.80. Chart 3 shows this evolution in land concentration through the Lorenz curves for the three censuses.

To complete the picture on trends in land concentration, it is interesting to look at the parcelation and fragmentation processes. While in 1974 the average number of parcels per holding was 1.12, this figure changed to 1.31 in 1986 and to 1.32 in the present census. At the same time the mean area of holdings with land dropped from 6.9 acres in 1974 to 5.4 in 1986 and 4.4 in 1996.

3.4. Land use

Upon comparison of the use of land reported in the last three censuses of agriculture, it can be seen that the agricultural land increased its participation in the total. This increase of 0.6% with respect to 1986, is due to: a strong increase of land with pastures (2352.3 acres more than in 1986); a moderate increase in the participation of land with permanent and medium term crops (despite a decrease of 4735 acres) and a decrease in area of arable land (temporary crops and fallow land) of 3586 acres. This last mentioned decrease caused a decrease in the participation of these lands from 13.8% in 1986 to 8.9% now. If the comparison is extended to cover the 1973/74 Agricultural Census, it can be noted that the 0.6% of increase in the participation of agricultural land is very small compared with the 14.8% of increase observed in the previous intercensal period. The above mentioned strong increase of land with pastures means a partial recover of lands under this use in 1974 (5821.6 acres more than in 1986). At the same time there are 5897.8 acres more than in 1974 with permanent crops. The observed decrease of arable land during the last intercensal period continues a trend from 1974. Table 7 and Charts 4 and 5 present the various main uses of land in the three censuses, both in terms of area and in percentage participation in total land:






3.5. Land tenure

From Table 8 it can be seen that the structure of land tenure has presented only small changes in the ten-year period since the last agricultural census. Family land continues to be the predominant form of land tenure (more than 45%). An increase in the number of parcels owned (1098 in absolute terms and 3.7% in participation in total) is noted since 1986. This increase accompanies a decrease in the number of parcels squatted (157 parcels less than in 1986 and their participation in total has dropped from 10.8% to 6.6%). Chart 6 shows these structures.




3.6. Population and Employment


Total population on farm households holdings has decreased since the previous census and it is almost equal to the farm household population recorded in 1973/74. However the total number of permanent agricultural workers remained practically unchanged since the last census. It's relation with the total national population decreased from 0.16 to 0.13 that is permanent agricultural workers per person. It must be noted that both figures are not strictly comparable because the time reference to be considered as "permanent worker" has been changed from 4 months in 1986 to 6 months for the 1996 census. This change in the definition should not affect the results significantly. Table 9 and Chart 7 show these changes.

Looking at the spatial distribution of population in agricultural holdings it is noted that the majority of persons in these holdings are concentrated in Castries and Micoud. 23.9 % and 19.2% of the total population on holdings are located in Castries and Micoud respectively. There is no information from the 1986 Census of Agriculture for comparison.

Comparison with the 1973/74 Agriculture Census revealed the loss in proportion of population holdings from 4.5 % to 0.9 %. Soufriere, Choiseul, and Dennery also showed some decrease in their proportion of population on holdings. Meanwhile, a marked increase of population on holdings is noticeable in Micoud and Vieux Fort. In analyzing the origin of these changes, it is interesting to look at the average size of the households on holdings per administrative district. For example the decrease of population in Canaries is both due to the less number of holdings and the decrease in the number of persons per household (from 6.54 - the largest proportion in 1974 to 3.30 persons per household - the smallest proportion of all administrative districts - in 1996).

On the contrary, the decrease in the average size for Dennery is reflected from the decrease at national level (about 26%). The average size of Dennery's households is one of the largest in the island. Therefore the decline in Dennery's percentage of population on holdings is mainly due to a reduction in the number of holdings. Micoud is the only administrative district which showed an increase in the the average size of the farmers' families. Therefore, the increase of Micoud's population on holdings is due to both a greater number of holdings and a larger family size.



Total number of permanent workers not belonging to the farmer's household can be dissagregated by type of worker and can be compared with the last census figures (See Table 11). It is interesting to observe that the decreasing in the number of workers (-4%) was higher for female workers (-5.8%) than for male ones (-3.2%). Besides that, it is noted a strong decrease in non-paid work (-60%) and inside it in the class age of less than 15 years old (-86%). In absolute figures, the decrease of 336 permanent agricultural workers is due to a decrease of 1427 non-paid workers and an increase of 835 paid workers. These changes ocurred for both sexes at a greater rate for women (-63% unpaid women vs. -58% unpaid men and +18% paid women vs. +11% paid men.).

3.7 Main characteristics of holders

In the Census of Agriculture, holders are classified by some important characteristics. In general, according to their legal status, more than 99 % of holdings in 1986 and more than 97.5 % in 1996 are operated on an individual basis. For that reason it is interesting to analyze the profile of this individual holders. This characteristics refer to sex, age, size of their holdings and size of their households and occupation.


The typical St. Lucian holder is a man, about 45 years old, whose main occupation is agriculture, operating a holding less than one acre of total size in only one parcel of land, living in a three to four - person household, working alone or with members of his family on a temporary basis. These characteristics arise from the modal values for those variables in the 1996 census of agriculture. These characteristics have not changed from the previous census.

It is interesting to analyze the particularities of holdings according to the sex of the holder. Table 12 summarizes the main characteristics for the last two censuses. From that table it can be noted that: female holders are older than male holders, operate holdings a little smaller on average than male holders, head greater households, only a little more than one half has agriculture as her main occupation (against almost 61% of male holders) and less than two out of five of their households receive more than 50 % of their income from agriculture (vs. almost one half of the male holdings' households). Since 1986, there has been a small increase in the participation of women operating holdings (from 24.6% to 26.3%). Chart 9 shows the percentage of individual holdings by sex of holder.

3.8 Main crops

Table 13 and Charts 11 and 12 compare the number of trees of main crops for the last two agricultural censuses. With the exception of coconuts, all the other main crops present an increase in comparison to 1986. This fact together with the decrease observed in area dedicated to permanent crops (see Section 3.4.) indicate a more intensive use of land under these crops.







3.9 Livestock

Some changes occurred in the number of animals on holdings. A small decrease in the number of cattle was compensated with a strong increase in number of pigs, sheep and goats. These changes are compatible with the observed trend in land use (See Section 3.4.). It must be noted that the figure for 1986 did not include chicks. However an important increase in the other categories of poultry is noticeable. Table 14 and Chart 13 present livestock information for the two last agricultural censuses.


3.10. Machinery and equipment

The level of mechanization and investment in farming was investigated in the 1996 agricultural census. There is no processed information on machinery and equipment for the 1986 census. Nevertheless, some comparison were made with the information obtained from the 1973/74 agricultural census. There is a conceptual difference between both censuses: while the 1973/74 census took information on number of machinery and equipment on holding on census day, the 1996 census collected information on the number of machinery and equipment used on holding during 1995. Since, the renting of machinery is not a extended practice in the country, figures from both censuses are roughly comparable. Table 15 and Chart 14 show the changes operated for these items in the 22-year period. Although the level of mechanization is still low in the island, a strong increase in the number of machinery and equipment has taken place in that period.

3.11 <u>Use of fertilizers</u>

Unlike the 1986 agricultural census that collected information on number of bags of fertilizers used by type of fertilizer, the 1996 census only took information on number of holdings using fertilizers by type. Table 16 compares the number of holdings reporting the use of the different type of fertilizers.


