

## **Foreword**

The Annual Agricultural Review is a publication of the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries, Physical Planning, Natural Resources and Cooperatives prepared by the Corporate Planning Unit. It provides current and historical statistical data, analyses and information on the agricultural sector in Saint Lucia. It is expected that the various stakeholders within the agriculture sector, learning institutions, partner agencies and the general community will find this publication informative and relevant for their decision making and development planning.

The staff of the Corporate Planning Unit in particular and the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries Physical Planning, Natural Resources and Cooperatives would like to take this opportunity to thank all those individuals, agencies and corporate entities, who so willingly support this initiative by supplying the data needed for the review exercise. We would also like to extend our gratitude to those who provided suggestions or criticisms regarding the improvement of this publication.

This edition presents historical data from 2013 with specific focus on the period January to December 2017.

### **Regional Developments**

In 2017, a 2.2 percent economic upturn was recorded for the Eastern Caribbean Currency Union (ECCU), with most member states exhibiting increased economic activity. Antigua recorded the highest rate of economic growth at 4.4 percent, followed by Grenada at 3.7 percent and Saint Lucia at 2.5 percent. This was mainly attributed to thriving tourism and construction industries. (ECCB, 2017).

The passage of hurricanes Irma and Maria, however, adversely impacted the region, causing projected economic growth for the ECCU to be downgraded. This is particularly evident in Dominica which registered negative growth of 4.4 percent. Anguilla also recorded negative growth of 3.5 percent, while Saint Vincent and the Grenadines recorded minimal growth at 0.8 percent. (ECCB, 2017).

### **Domestic Developments:**

Saint Lucia's economy expanded in 2017 by 2.5 percent. This was attributed to growth in the construction and the hotel and restaurant sector. However, the government ran a fiscal deficit as opposed to the fiscal surplus of the previous year. The deficit stemmed primarily from the current account, as increasing imports expenditure coupled with declining export earnings created a merchandise trade deficit. In addition, public debt grew as government accumulated debt from foreign sources.

Commercial banks remained fairly liquid and an increase in net foreign assets was registered. Monetary liabilities and domestic credit declined. Saint Lucia continues to face downside risks, including adverse impacts of climate change and natural disasters. (ECCB, 2017)

## Overview of the Agricultural Sector

Growth in the Agriculture Sector was negative in 2017, having contracted by 6.2 percent. This is a direct contrast to the previous year where the sector grew by 2.9 percent. Total agricultural GDP also exhibited a 6 percent decline from EC\$77.8 million to EC\$73 million. Growth within most subsectors contracted, except that of bananas which exhibited a 6 percent increase, and that of Forestry, which exhibited growth of 0.8 percent.

## **Bananas**

Total banana exports to the United Kingdom exhibited a 25 percent increase from 7,092 tonnes in 2016 to 8,898 tonnes in 2017. Regional banana exports, however, declined by 29 percent with a corresponding quantity of 2,037 less tonnes being exported. Barbados was the main regional export destination, having accounted for 53 percent of regional exports.

## **Non-traditional Crops**

The quantity of local agricultural produce purchased by supermarkets declined by three (3) percent, while the quantity purchased by hotels fell by a further seven (7) percent. There was a decrease in most crop categories purchased by both supermarkets and hotels, particularly fruit and tree crops.

## **Fisheries**

The total quantity of fish landed declined from 1,732 tonnes to 1,669 tonnes, representing a 3.6 percent decrease. The harvest sites which yielded the most fish were Vieux Fort, accounting for 31.4 percent of the local fish supply, followed by Dennery at 22.9 percent and Micoud at 7.5 percent. Non-sample sites collectively accounted for a considerable proportion of the local supply at 18.4 percent. The three most common fish species were tuna, dolphin and king fish, together accounting for 63 percent of the local fish supply. Fish imports declined by 10 percent.

## **Livestock**

There was a substantial increase in poultry imports of 38.7 percent – an increase of approximately 3,000 tonnes. In turn, local poultry production declined by 4.6 percent. Saint Lucia imported almost four times as much chicken as it produced, with local chicken production standing at 2,175.4 tonnes and imported chicken standing at 8,255 tonnes. Egg production declined as well, with the quantity of eggs produced falling by 18.2 percent and the average laying stock of farm hens by 14.5 percent. Pork imports accounted for 49.3 percent of meat imports, while beef imports accounted for 32.9 percent.

## Banana Industry

Banana exports to the United Kingdom increased by 25 percent in 2017 valued at EC\$14.5 million. In the first quarter of 2017, the Saint Lucia National Fair Trade Organization (SLNFTO) was the sole banana exporting company. By the second quarter, there was a 274 percent increase in exports, followed by a 19 percent increase in the third quarter and a smaller 1 percent increase in the fourth quarter. This increase in banana exports was partly due to efforts by the government to increase banana output through the provision of support to farmers under the Banana Productivity Improvement Project in the form of subsidized inputs and post -Matthew rehabilitation works on farm roads and drainage.

The SLNFTO handled the majority of bananas exported in 2017 (96 percent) followed by Tropical Quality Fruit Company (TQFC) who handled the remaining 4 percent of bananas exported in 2017.

Regional banana exports fell by 29 percent in 2017, the equivalent of approximately 2,037 tonnes of bananas valued at EC\$4.7 million. Trinidad and Tobago was previously Saint Lucia's main destination for regional banana exports, but this was no longer the case in 2017 as exports to Trinidad & Tobago plummeted by 83 percent. This was due to the inability of St. Lucia to supply bananas to Trinidad in the aftermath of Tropical Storm Matthew resulting in Trinidad sourcing bananas from other countries in the region. Saint Lucia primarily exported bananas to Barbados and Antigua in 2017, the two of which accounted for 53 percent and 33 percent respectively of banana exports in 2017.

The total value of domestic exports increased by 13.8 percent in 2017 to EC\$210 million. The value of total agricultural exports and banana exports declined by 4 percent to EC\$25 million and 3.7 percent to EC\$22 million respectively, primarily as a result of a decline in the total value of bananas exported in 2017. The value of total banana exports accounted for 88.6 percent of the value of total agricultural exports in 2017 while the value of total agricultural exports in 2017 accounted for 11.8 percent of the total value of domestic exports in 2017, indicative of the necessity to increase the total volumes of agricultural commodities exported.



The prices of banana inputs remained fairly constant in 2017. There were no increases in the price of banana inputs in 2018. There were decreases in the price of twine (41%), Fertilizer N.P.K. (16.8.24+2.4) (18%), Amistar fungicide (19%) and a 9 percent decrease in Vidate nematicide. All weedicides, except for one, registered slight price decreases.

## **Non – Traditional Crops**

The total volume of local agricultural produce purchased by selected marketing outlets and hotels declined further in 2017. Inconsistencies in the supply of local agricultural produce partly attributed to unfavorable weather conditions contributed to a decline in the volumes of agricultural produce purchased by marketing outlets and hotels in 2017. Overall, supermarkets purchased approximately 3.3 times more local agricultural produce than hotels in 2017.

The total volumes of local agricultural produce purchased by selected marketing outlets, declined by 3 percent in 2017. Consequently, there was a decrease in revenue of EC\$228, 066. Most crops recorded a reduction in quantity purchased. The most significant reductions include fruit and tree crops which fell by 13.3 percent, root crops which fell by 7. 2 percent and Musa species which fell by 2 percent. On the other hand, miscellaneous crops registered a 13.1 percent increase and generated \$84, 974 more revenue than in 2016 and vegetables registered a 1 percent increase in the total volumes purchased by selected marketing outlets and a 5 percent decrease in value, indicating a decrease in the prices of vegetables purchased by selected marketing outlets.



For the second consecutive year, the quantity of local agricultural produce purchased by selected hotels decreased. However, the decline in 2017 was less pronounced than that of 2016, with 2017 recording a 7 percent decrease Vis a Vis a 13 percent decrease in 2016. The decline in quantity purchased in 2017 resulted in an EC\$279,709 decline in revenue.

There was a decrease in the quantity purchased of most crops, with fruit and tree crops exhibiting the greatest decline of 15.5 percent, followed by Musa species and vegetables, which fell by 3.9 percent and 3.6 percent respectively. Contrarily, the quantity of miscellaneous crops increased by 97 percent. In turn, revenue generated from these crops in 2017 nearly doubled that of 2016 as revenue increased by 98.9 percent.





## Fisheries Sector

There was a 3.6 percent decrease in the estimated total quantity of fish landed from 1, 732 tonnes in 2016 to 1, 669 tonnes in 2017. This fall in tonnage may be the result of several factors, including high levels of sargassum seaweed and shifts in participation of persons from fishing to other activities.

The landing sites in Vieux Fort, Dennery and Micoud accounted for the largest quantity of fish landed in St.Lucia. The quantity of fish landed on non-sample sites also formed a sizable proportion of the total quantity of fish landed. While Dennery and Micoud recorded increases in fish landings of 6.4 percent and 9.6 percent respectively, fish landings in Vieux-fort and Non-sample sites declined by 1.1 percent and 18.6 percent respectively.

Tuna, Dolphin and King Fish species were the major fish species landed in 2017, with tuna forming 32 percent of the local supply, dolphin 24 percent and king fish accounting for 7percent of the total volumes of fish species landed in 2017. Other fish species collectively, including snapper, lobster and lionfish, accounted for 37percent of the total quantity of fish landed.



The tonnage of fish imported decreased by 10 percent in 2017. The value of imported fish in 2017 grew by 1.4 percent to EC\$21.9 million, indicating an increase in the prices of imported fish during the period under review. Despite an overall decline in total fish imports, imports of frozen and chilled fish rose by 6.5 percent and imports of canned fish rose by 9.6 percent. There was, however, a 36 percent decrease in the imports of other types of fish which resulted in an overall decline in the quantity of total fish imports.


In 2017, total fish imports exceeded local fish landings by 86 tonnes. Saint Lucia generated more revenue from its local fish supply than it spent on fish imports. The value of the local fish supply for 2017 was EC\$28 million while total fish import expenditure was lower at EC\$22 million.

## **Livestock Sector**

### **Poultry Imports**

Total poultry imports increased by 40 percent, having risen from 6,737 tonnes in 2016 to 9,436 tonnes in 2017. Consequently, total poultry import expenditure increased by 7.6 percent. Chicken imports accounted for 87 percent of total poultry imports and rose by 38.8 tonnes to 8,255 tonnes. Turkey accounted for 12.2 percent of total poultry imports and increased by 46 percent to 1,151 tonnes.

Imports of whole poultry remained constant in 2017 when compared with the corresponding period in 2016 at 47 tonnes. The value of whole poultry imports declined by 32.6 percent in 2017. This may be attributed to a decrease in the price of whole poultry in 2017. The quantity of necks, backs and wings imported in 2017 grew by 17.2 percent to 4,513 tonnes in 2017 while imports of other poultry parts increased by 71.8 percent to 4,876 tonnes.

## Egg Production


The average laying stock on farms (number of hens) fell by 14.5 percent from 76, 000 hens to 65,000 hens in 2017. As a result, there was an 18.2 percent decrease in the quantity of locally produced eggs and a 24.5 percent decrease in total revenue to EC\$8.0 million. Saint Lucia continued to be self-sufficient in egg production in 2017 which resulted in zero eggs imports under the review period.

## Local Poultry Production

Total local poultry production declined by 3.4 percent, from 2,251.4 tonnes in 2016 to 2,175.4 tonnes in 2017. This corresponds with a decrease in value of EC\$1.3 million. Production of whole chicken and mixed parts fell by 3.2 percent and 3.5 percent respectively. This decrease in production resulted in a decline in the value of locally produced whole chicken and mixed parts of 5.5 percent and 4.3 percent respectively.



## **Local Pork Industry**


A slight decline of 0.9 percent in pork purchases was recorded in 2017. Purchases fell from 206.4 tonnes in 2016 to 204.6 tonnes in 2017, while the value of pork purchases consequently fell by 3.2 percent to EC\$2.7 million.

Pork constituted the highest level of meat imports in 2017. Pork imports doubled in 2017, increasing by 101 percent to 1,302 tonnes. Expenditure on pork imports grew by 10 percent to EC\$8 million indicating a possible decline in the price of imported pork. Beef constituted the second highest level of meat imports in 2017 at 868 tonnes, a 58.7 percent increase from 2016. This is followed by mutton at 396 tonnes, a 54.7 percent increase from 2016. Chevron was the least imported meat at only 75 tonnes, but still recorded a significant increase in tonnage of 226 percent. Overall, the value of chevron and mutton registered the most substantial increases, with chevron registering a 175 percent increase in value and mutton registering a 50 percent increase.




### Meat Imports - 2017

## **Import of Selected Livestock Products**


Milk represented 75 percent of total livestock products imported in 2017, followed by cheese which constituted 22 percent and butter/butterfat which constituted 3 percent. Total milk imports declined by 15.7 percent in 2017, from 4,652 tonnes in 2016 to 3,923 tonnes in 2017. There was a 2 percent decline in cheese imports, while butter/butterfat imports showed an increase of 45 percent. Overall, total imports of livestock products decreased from 5,948 tonnes in 2016 to 5,255 tonnes in 2017, representing a 12 percent decline from 2016.




## **Agricultural Financing**


Notwithstanding a decline in the number of loans approved for Agricultural and Fishing Activities over the past four years (2013-2016), 2017 registered an increase in the number of loans approved for Agricultural and Fishing Activities, albeit at a minimal amount of eight (8) percent. Total loans remained relatively low as one additional loan was granted in 2017. However, the value of total loans grew exponentially, particularly loans for livestock activities (mainly poultry). The value of total loans exhibited a 547 percent increase from EC\$241, 000 to EC\$1.5 million. Loans for livestock activities increased from one loan in 2016 to three loans in 2017 and the value of livestock loans exhibited a 4,560 percent growth, having increased from EC\$25,000 to EC\$1.2 million.

On the contrary, the number of loans granted for fishing activities decreased by 50 percent, having fallen from two loans in 2016 to one loan in 2017, with a corresponding fall in value of EC\$23, 000. Moreover, the number of loans granted for crop development activities declined by 43 percent, having been reduced from seven loans in 2016 to four loans in 2017. However, the value of this loan category increased by 53.6 percent to EC\$86,000 in 2017.

## **Food Trade Balance**

For the past four consecutive years, Saint Lucia's trade balance on food exhibited significant deficits and 2017 was no exception. The deficit worsened by 4.8 percent to EC\$318.2 million in 2017 and the level of food imports was almost ten times that of food exports. Although food exports showed a 41.6 percent increase with a corresponding increase in value of EC\$10.7 million, this was insufficient to close the gap between imports and exports. Food import expenditure increased by 7.7 percent to EC\$354.7 million in 2017. Food exports did, however, comprise a more substantial proportion of total domestic exports in 2017, comprising 17 percent of domestic exports as opposed to 14 percent in 2016 valued at EC\$36.5 million in 2017.


Total domestic exports rose by 13.9 percent to EC\$209.5 million in 2017. Total imports also increased, though on a smaller scale. Total imports grew by 8.2 percent to EC\$1.8 billion in 2017.

## **Composition of Food Imports**

For the fifth consecutive year, meat and meat preparations, cereal and cereal preparations, vegetables and fruits and dairy products and eggs were the four major categories of food items imported in 2017, together comprising 70 percent of total food imports. All four categories exhibited increases in the value of imports, thus contributing to the increased food import bill which grew by 7.8 percent to EC\$354.9 million in 2017.

The value of imports of meat and meat preparations rose by 28.8 percent to EC\$74.3 million. This was followed by a 59 percent increase in cereal and cereal preparations imports with a corresponding value of EC\$67.4 million in 2017. Vegetables and fruits grew by 10 percent to EC\$64.3 million while imports of dairy products and eggs increased by 3.7 percent to EC\$42.3 million in 2017.

## **Exports of Selected Agricultural Produce**

Exports of selected agricultural produce declined by 35.8 percent in 2017. Exports decreased from 8,760.8 tonnes valued at EC\$11.1 million in 2016 to 5,620.1 tonnes valued at EC\$6.2 million in 2017.

The four main regional exports for 2017, with the exception of bananas, were plantain, breadfruit, mango and avocado. The two largest exports plantain and breadfruit which made up 82 percent of non-traditional crop exports, exhibited declines. Plantain declined by 50 percent with a corresponding decrease in value of EC\$626,930. Similarly, Breadfruit exports declined by 51 percent to 215 tonnes valued at EC\$495,000 in 2017. Contrarily, mango and avocado registered increases in export tonnage and value in 2017. Exports of mango grew by 15 percent to 95 tonnes valued at EC\$248,000 while avocado exports increased by 20 percent to 30,000 tonnes with a corresponding value of EC\$90,000.

For the past four years, pineapple exports were zero. However, in 2017, 1.8 tonnes of pineapple valued at EC\$6,790 were exported. Notwithstanding a decline in the tonnage of hot peppers exported by 77.6 percent to 1,800 tonnes in 2017, the value of hot peppers exports increased by 12 percent to EC\$313 thousand in 2017.
