**CONDITIONS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF TABLES EGGS INTO ST. LUCIA**

1. The eggs must be accompanied by a certificate signed by the Veterinary Authority of the exporting country, which in this case is the United States Department of Agriculture. Such certificate shall state that:
  - i) The eggs originated from a farm/s where Avian Influenza has not been detected or the virus isolated, and there have been no outbreaks of New Castle Disease, Avian Influenza in the State for the past twelve (12) months.
  - ii) The flock/s from which these eggs were derived were inspected and were in good health and free from clinical symptoms of communicable disease.
  - iii) The farm/s must be subjected to regular USDA inspections and the
    - a. flocks must be certified and free of the following diseases:
    - b. Salmonellosis
    - c. Fowl Cholera
    - d. Avian Influenza
    - e. New Castle Disease
  - iv) The eggs are wholesome and fit for human consumption
